Objectives: (cf. the CECRL when applicable)	<p>I can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • use words to describe a person • understand vocabulary related to characterizing different personal relationships • begin to use and understand comparative structures • begin to use imperative expressions such as “il faut + infinitive” • conduct an administrative procedure in French • spot job listings and requirements • begin to formulate in plus que parfait • begin to learn and understand relative pronouns such as “qui” and “que” and “a qui” and “avec qui” to be able to give more specific details • tell of an experience or story (imparfait) • make past participles agree when using “être” in the “passé composé” tense • express obligation, the banning of something, and give advice/suggestions. • begin to use the subjonctif • use “c’est... qui/c’est...” for emphasizing something • use temporal markers such as “il y a”, “pendant”, “depuis”, and “dans”

As we explore different themes, students will increase their French vocabulary. We will learn about French culture throughout the session.
